GET PREPARED

- Take an on-campus or guided virtual tour. gograd.unt.edu/tours
- Connect with a **graduate advisor or key faculty** in your area(s) of interest to discuss graduate school options and admission requirements.* gograd.unt.edu/advising
- Prepare your application materials at least **two months prior** to your department's application date. **International applicants may need additional time to process documents.**

TWO-PART APPLICATION PROCESS

The UNT graduate application is a **concurrent two-part process**. All applicants must complete the Toulouse Graduate School admission requirements, but most programs have additional requirements.

- 1 **Apply with our general university application** at ApplyTexas.org and pay the \$75 application fee. Send official transcripts from all colleges attended to UNT admissions.
- 2 **Apply to your department** and submit all supporting application materials.

Complete the graduate application by the following dates. Check with your departmental advisor for specific deadlines and details.**
